- Attend the Pony Club Australia National Championships in Toowoomba from September 18th – 22nd 2017 for the purpose of coaching the PCV Eventing Team

Qualifications and Experience

- Current NCAS Coaching qualification with Eventing Experience. Eventing specialist highly regarded
- Current Working with Children Check Card
- Demonstrated competition experience up to Two Star will be highly regarded
- Experience in riding and training horses to Two Star level will be highly regarded

- High level communication skills
- High degree of personal and professional integrity and an ability to follow the principles laid down in the Coaches Code of Conduct

Remuneration
